

Appellants allege that the Procedures are invalid because Director LeFleur exceeded his and ADEM's statutory authority and violated the notice and comment requirements of the Alabama Administrative Procedure Act and Alabama Environmental Management Act. The invalidity of the Procedures preclude Appellants from obtaining valid resolutions of any complaints alleging that ADEM actions resulted in discriminatory effects.
